



**YMCA Youth Golf Course Guide
Legacy Pines Golf Club**

Background

Legacy Pines is a public course that’s a lot of fun! You can choose to either play holes #1-3 or holes #1-6/7. Younger groups should play holes #1-3 which leaves you behind the driving range and just a short walk back to the parking lot. Older groups that choose to play holes #1-6 or 7, will finish on the eastern side of the driving range with a short walk back to the parking lot.

Tee Boxes – Starting Place in Fairway

Since this is a full-size, regulation golf course, we will NOT be using the traditional tee boxes. Instead we will be starting from either the 100 yard marker, the 150 yard marker, or for more advanced groups – the 200 yard marker. We will be starting from the middle of the fairway on all par 4s and par 5s. On par 3 holes, advanced teams can play from the red tees while teams with younger, beginners should pick a place half way between the red tee box and the green.

*****Choose the appropriate yardage for your team’s level of skill/experience.**

Fairway Yardage Markers:

100 yards: Red Plate in middle of fairway, red stripe on cart path

150 yards: Green Plate in the fairway, white bird houses on side of fairway, white stripe on cart path

200 yards: Blue plate in middle of fairway, blue stripe on cart path

****Red 100 yard marker might be too long for some groups. If so, just pick a good place to start from about half way between the red plate and the green.*

<u>Holes to Play</u>	<u>Beginner</u>	<u>Advanced</u>	<u>Time Limit</u>
#1 – Par 5 (downhill)	150-200 yards (top of hill)	200-225 yards	11-12 min
#2 – Par 4	100 yards	150 yard	8-10 min
#3 – Par 4	100 yards	150 yards	8 -10min
<u>Following holes are OPTIONAL:</u>			
#4 – Par 3	~75 yards (bottom of hill)	154 yards (red tee)	8-10 min
#5 – Par 4	100 yards	150 yards	8-10 min
#6 – Par 5	150 yards (uphill)	200 yards	12-13 min
#7 – Par 4			

Course Notes

- It’s recommended that most teams play holes #1-3. Holes #4-6 are challenging and should only be played by more advanced and experienced teams
- Please rake all bunkers and repair ball marks on greens
- When you finish on #3 or #6, please be VERY careful walking back near the driving range.
